

THE UNIFIED CONTRACT FOR LAWYER FEES



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ENHANCING PREVENTIVE JUSTICE

The Saudi Ministry of Justice has officially launched the Unified Contract for Lawyer Fees, led by His Excellency the Minister of Justice and Chairman of the Saudi Bar Association, Walid Al-Samaani. This unified legal contract aims to regulate the contractual relationship between lawyers and clients under a clear and transparent framework, strengthening preventive justice in the Kingdom.



This Saudi unified contract is legally binding and enforceable, created through the Najiz platform and electronically processed by enforcement courts via the Najiz.sa platform, thus removing the need for court proceedings to file lawsuits.

It provides clear documentation of legal services, including representation, consultations, document preparation, notifications, and fee transactions.
